ImagineNano 2013 strengthens its position as the largest European event dedicated to nanoscience and nanotechnology

In parallel, ImagineNano 2013 held an exceptional industrial exhibition showcasing cutting-edge advances in nanotechnology research and development with more than 160 institutions represented.

The outstanding results of participation that have been reached and the interest created by the discussions, have laid the foundations for the **next edition of the event, which will be held in 2015**, maintaining the different topics of the seven conferences of ImagineNano 2013.

Organized by Phantoms Foundation, CIC nanoGUNE, Donostia International Physics Centre (DIPC) and Euskampus UPV/EHU in collaboration with the Bilbao Exhibition Centre (BEC) and the Congress Division of Viajes El Corte Inglés, the second edition of ImagineNano included, among other main attractions, the participation of important scientists and researchers from different countries around the World.
